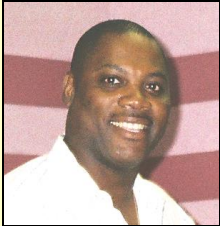
New Transportation...

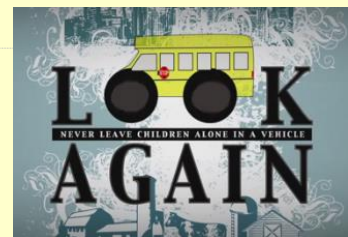
What's The Issue...?

"Look Again" Campaign...

Georgia leaders promote the "Look Again" campaign to prevent parents and caregivers from leaving children unattended in vehicles, warning of the escalating chance of serious injury or death if children are left alone in cars for even a short period of time.

Parents, please check backseats and floorboards each time you exit the car, and lock the door when you park at home so a wandering child can't trap themselves in the vehicle.

One child left unattended in a vehicle is one child too many.
